SUNSET OR SUCCESS?

This new year, 2024, has the potential to dangerously alter the course of America and the lives we live. Casting your vote in 2024 might be the most important vote you will ever cast. Will it be the last vote you cast? **WE** have to make sure our elected officials are representing us!

When President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan into law on March 11, 2021, participants of Central States had their pensions saved. Had this not happened, Central States would have been unable to pay our pensions beyond early 2026.

How did this happen? Answer: <u>Record Voter turnout</u>. In the 2020 National Election cycle more people cast ballots for the President of the United States than any time in our Nation's history. This turnout caused upsets in two U.S. Senate races in Georgia alone. In a parting of the Red Sea moment, the two Georgia Senators (Warnock and Ossoff) made the difference and voted to save our pensions. The two Senators they defeated were opposed to saving our pensions.

We are now facing another uphill battle to save Social Security and Medicare again. Florida Senator Rick Scott has called for the sunsetting of both programs after five years. Sunsetting a program means ending that program unless Congress votes to keep the program or change it. You remember Rick Scott, CEO of Columbia/HCA when it paid a \$1.7 billion fine for Medicare fraud; the same Rick Scott who under questioning in a deposition pled the Fifth Amendment **SEVENTY-FIVE** (75) separate times so as not to incriminate himself. He wants you to trust him that sunsetting Social Security and Medicare is best for you.

Currently, Congress can't agree on a budget bill, aid to Israel, Aid to Ukraine, immigration reform, gun safety, defense spending, further action on climate change, women's healthcare rights, voting rights and the list goes on. One Senator by himself jeopardized our military security by halting pending military promotions.

Think about this: Had your pension not been secured under the American Rescue Plan in 2021, and Florida Senator Rick Scott's original plan to sunset (end) Social Security and Medicare had succeeded, how would you and your family survived past early 2026?

The key is to make sure you vote like your life depends on it, because it does!



50-60 AND 70'S MUSIC.




