PENSION UPDATE/RESCUE PLAN IN PLACE

On Wednesday July 6th, President Joe Biden announced the finalization of the program to financially assist multi-employer pension funds. President Biden stated "Those retirees who lost their benefits will have them restored retroactively." Biden further added "We turned a promise broken into a promise kept."

Roughly 1400 multi-employer pension funds covering 11 million participants (former truck drivers, construction workers, dairy, linen, manufacturing, etc.) are now safe through at least to the year 2051.

Plans that were threatened with near term insolvency (close to 200) have been approved for nearly \$ 7 billion in assistance as of the writing of this article by the PBGC. PBGC expects to distribute (to defined benefit plans) a minimum of \$74 billion and possibly up to as much as \$91 billion worth of financial help to multi-employer plans.

The best aspect of The American Rescue Plan signed into law by President Biden, is that the money is in place. Should the next Congress want to pass a tax cut scheme for the rich, the next Congress won't be able to take our pensions away from us, the blue collar retirees, to fund it!

The American Rescue Plan's Special Financial Assistance Program Will Have Historic Impacts:

- Positions multiemployer plans that receive assistance to remain solvent through at least 2051 with no cuts to earned benefits.
- Protect benefits for millions of workers who faced cuts.



On Saturday March 19,2022 shortly after 5:00 AM, Adam was in training for a triathlon and was riding his bicycle on the south bound side of North Dale Mabry Highway near the US 41 divide. According to the Florida Highway Patrol, Adam was struck by a passing motorist who fled the scene. With his bicycle still on the roadway, another driver (motorcyclist) hit Adam's bike, stopped and found Adam and notified authorities. Adam had to be airlifted to a hospital. Adam suffered major traumatic injuries and has not regained consciousness. As of May 3rd, Adam is still comatose and progressing slowly. As yet the FHP does not have a description of the vehicle involved.

Adam who is a graduate of Tampa Jesuit, first joined Local 79 in 2020 while working for YRC. He later went to work for ABF in March of this year. Adam is married and has a 6 year old son.

A Go Fund Me account has been established on Adam's behalf and thus far has raised just over \$ 21,000 for Adam's care. If you go to www.gofundme.com, click the search button and put in Adam Kaplan's name and his fundraiser will come up. Our Teamster brother is in need and if you can help, please do because we all know, once a Teamster, always a Teamster!



ELECTION SEASON 2022

Election season is upon us with many local and statewide races to be run as well as Federal races in the House and Senate. The primary election day is August 23, 2022. The general election is November 8, 2022. In preparation to cast your ballot, Local 79's Retiree Club's Political Director Larry Dupree says it is important to have your updated Voted ID Registration card, know your polling place location, and have a current signature on file. Larry adds that if you wish to continue voting by mail, please notify the Supervisor of Elections Office in your county that you wish to continue voting by mail.
